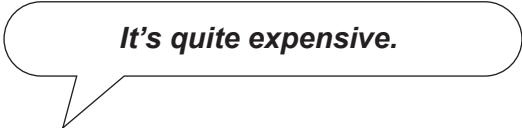


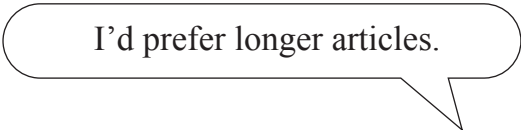
Exercise 6**Question 17**

You recently bought a copy of a new magazine which is aimed at teenagers. You decide to review the magazine, and you will post the review on your school website.

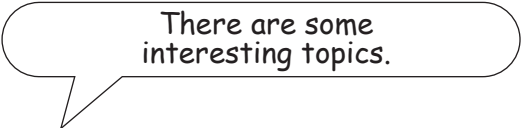
Here are some comments about the magazine from your friends:



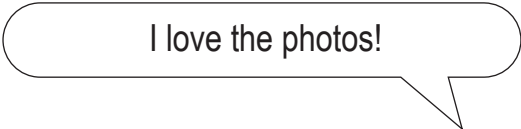
It's quite expensive.
