

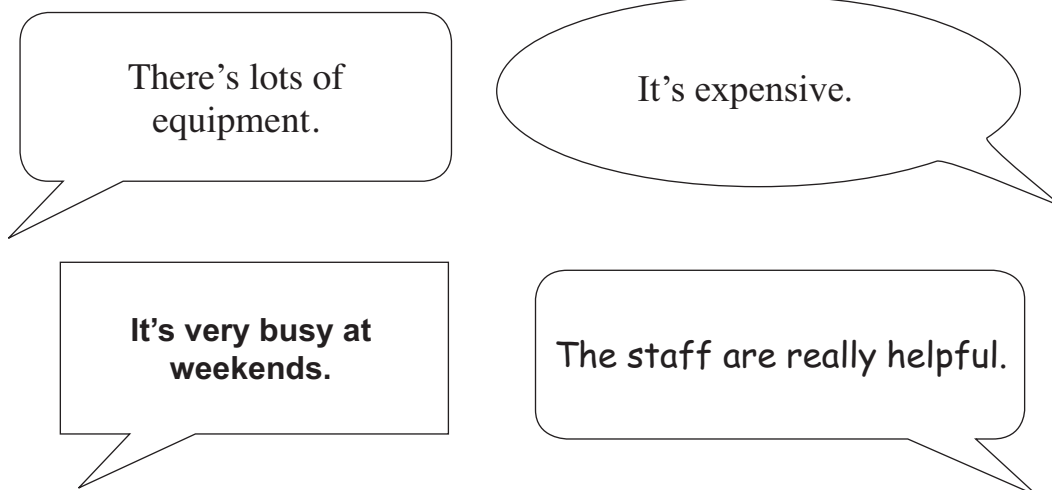


Exercise 6
